  - Mogollon
  - Williams
  - Montezuma
  - Payson
  - Winslow
  - Grand Canyon
- A minimum of 3 flight hours are required within 90 days preceding the award application deadline.

## **Female Student Pilot Milestone AWARD**

### **HOW IS THE SCHOLARSHIP PAID?**

The financial distributions are paid out for each goal, listed below, successfully completed within 12 months of receiving the award. The indicated amounts will be paid directly to the qualified instructor or flight school on the student pilot's behalf. A qualified instructor is one with a CFI certificate in good standing.

To request payment upon completion of one of the aviation goals, winner must provide a written request to the Sedona/Payson Scholarship Committee, who will then notify the treasurer to distribute the funds. In the event of unforeseen circumstances where winner is unable to complete the aviation goals within one year, one six (6) month extension may be granted upon progress review. A written request must be received by the Sedona/Payson Ninety-Nines Scholarship Committee before the end of the 12 month period after receipt of the scholarship.

### **SELECTION**

Applications are accepted up to two weeks prior to the deadline. The scholarship committee does not determine the winner. The scholarship winner will be chosen by an independent panel of outside judges on a point system. Consideration will be given for participation in activities that support women in aviation.

### **WHO WE ARE**

The Payson Rim Country Ninety-Nines and Sedona Red Rockettes Ninety-Nines are Chapters of The Ninety-Nines International organization of women pilots. **I certify that I meet the following requirements:**

- A strong passion for aviation, with the goal of earning a Private Pilot Certificate for fixed wing, helicopter, balloon or glider.
- The commitment, time, financial ability and persistence to work to complete this rating within one year of receiving the scholarship.
- Good physical health and am at least 17 years of age as of application due date. (If under 18, written parental permission is required.)
- A current FAA Student Pilot Certificate at the time of application or have a pending Student Pilot Certificate application in IACRA
- A valid Third Class Medical Certificate if required for the certificate sought, or if medical not yet obtained, I understand that a medical certificate will be required to receive funds if working towards a private certificate.
- I fly out of one of the following airports: Cottonwood, Flagstaff, Grapevine, Rimrock, Mogollon, Montezuma, Payson, Sedona, Winslow, Williams or Grand Canyon.
- Within 90 days of the scholarship deadline, logged 3 hours of certified flight time in aircraft (not including ground training). Two hours may be in an Advanced Aviation Training Device (AATD) or Flight Training Device (FTD) appropriate to the rating sought with CFI logbook entry).
- Confirmed that all completed pages of my required logbook are signed and hours tallied.

**I have included in my packet:**

- Completed current application form
- Appropriate copies from my log book showing the required 3 flight hours in the past 90 days from application deadline
- A copy of my medical certificate if required
- One page personal essay font size Arial 11 or larger addressing the required topics
- Copy of student pilot certificate (front and back)
- Signed parental consent, if under 18 years old
